Early Chronology & Later Career Highlights:

- 1953 - Begins to develop and print family negatives
- 1956 - Receives first 35mm camera
- 1958 - Given copy of Walker Evans' *American Photographs*
- 1962 - Edward Steichen purchases 3 photographs for MoMA
- 1965 - 16mm film, "Elevator", is shown at Filmmakers' Cinemateque, NYC
- 1965-1967 - Spends time at Warhol's Factory. Takes photographs, assists on films, works on lighting for Velvet Underground performances)
- 1968 - First major publication: *Andy Warhol*, Moderna Museet, Stockholm
- 1971 - First major exhibition: Metropolitan Museum of Art. This is the first solo show by a living photographer at the Met since Alfred Stieglitz, 40 years earlier.
- 1971 - Publishes *Greetings from Amarillo: Tall in Texas*, a set of ten postcards
- 1971 - Curates "All the Meat You Can Eat" at the 98 Greene Street Loft. An exhibition of vernacular photography: postcards, police pictures, pornography, advertising photography, press photos, etc.
